

What quota should be applied to FC-10M pigtail fiber



Article Overview

For FC-10M single-mode fiber pigtails, the recommended quota depends on network design, splicing points, and patch panel requirements, typically allocating one pigtail per termination point plus spares.

Key Considerations

1. Fiber Type and Connector

- FC-10M pigtails are usually single-mode (9/125 μ m) fibers with FC connectors on one end and a bare fiber on the other for splicing .
- Ensure the pigtail matches the network fiber type (single-mode vs multimode) to avoid high insertion loss .
- 2. Length
 - The "10M" indicates a 10-meter length, which is suitable for connecting distant patch panels or equipment racks without excessive slack .
 - For shorter distances, 3m or 5m pigtails may be more practical to reduce cable management issues.
- 3. Quota Calculation
 - Per termination point: Allocate one pigtail per fiber termination in a patch panel or enclosure.
 - Spare allowance: Include 10–20% extra to account for splicing errors, testing, or future expansion.
 - Example: For a rack with 48 fiber terminations, order 48–58 FC-10M pigtails.
- 4. Installation and Splicing
 - Pigtails are used for fusion or mechanical splicing to backbone fibers
