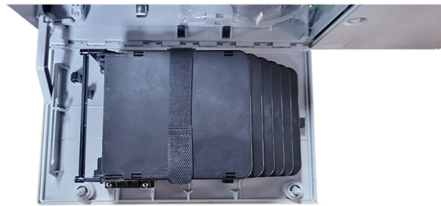


What s the relationship between fiber optic cables and routers

Routers do not transmit data over fiber directly; instead, they rely on signals converted from optical to electrical form.
