

What size cable is best for a network server rack



Article Overview

For modern server racks, use Cat6a or Cat8 for data connections and select power cables based on the appropriate AWG gauge for current load.

Data Cabling

For network connectivity within a server rack, the choice of cable depends on the required data rate and distance:

- Cat6a: Recommended as the baseline for most server-to-switch connections. Supports 10 Gbps up to 100 meters and mitigates interference such as Alien Crosstalk, especially in dense rack environments . Shielded Cat6a cables are preferred for high-density racks or PoE++ devices .
- Cat8: Suitable for short-distance, high-speed links (25–40 Gbps up to 30 meters), ideal for Top-of-Rack (ToR) or Middle-of-Row (MoR) architectures .
- Fiber Optic (Multi-mode or Single-mode): Used for backbone connections or switch-to-switch uplinks, providing high bandwidth and low latency .
- SFP+/DAC cables: Direct Attach Copper cables are recommended for short switch-to-switch connections to reduce heat and latency compared to copper RJ45 patch cables . Ensure proper cable management with loose bundling to prevent overheating, especially with PoE++ devices, and maintain bend radii according to standards .
