

When should the distribution box be installed

Proper installation of a distribution box ensures safety, compliance, and reliable power distribution across all circuits.

Choosing the Right Distribution Box

Select a box based on environment, load capacity, and durability. For indoor use, plastic enclosures are sufficient, while steel is preferred for industrial or outdoor settings due to its strength. Check the IP or NEMA rating to ensure protection against dust and water, especially for outdoor installations (IP66 or NEMA 4 is recommended). Ensure the box can accommodate current wiring and future expansion.

Location and Placement

Install the box in a dry, accessible area with good ventilation. Maintain a height of approximately 1.5 meters for residential setups; industrial heights may vary depending on surrounding equipment. Keep a safe distance from water, flammable, or corrosive substances, and leave space around the box for maintenance and heat dissipation.

Essential tools include a screwdriver, wire stripper, electric drill, multimeter, and insulation resistance tester. Materials include expansion bolts, fixing brackets, termi...
