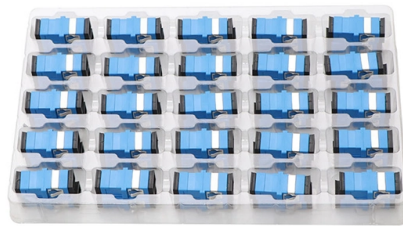

Speed and Performance

Fiber optic cables transmit data as light pulses through glass or plastic strands, allowing extremely high bandwidth and symmetrical speeds (upload and download speeds are nearly identical), often reaching 1 Gbps or higher for residential users, with potential for 10 Gbps+ in the future . Cable internet uses copper coaxial cables, which carry data as electrical signals. While cable can provide high download speeds (up to ~1 Gbps), upload speeds are typically much lower, and performance can degrade during peak usage hours due to shared bandwidth .

Fiber is highly reliable and immune to electromagnetic interference, maintaining stable connections even in harsh weather or near power lines . Cable is more susceptible to signal degradation over long distances and can experience slower speeds during network congestion . Fiber also offers lower latency, which is beneficial for online gaming, video conferencing, and cloud-based applications .
