Key Components and Wiring Equipment

- **Circuit Breakers and Fuses** Circuit breakers protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits, automatically disconnecting power when faults occur. Fuses serve a similar protective function but are single-use devices. Residual Current Circuit Breakers (RCCBs) detect imbalances between live and neutral wires, providing additional safety against electric shocks .
- **Busbars and Terminal Blocks** Busbars are metal strips that distribute electricity from the main input to multiple circuits. Terminal blocks provide secure connection points for wires, ensuring organized and reliable connections .
- **Grounding and Neutral Bars** Grounding bars safely direct excess current to the earth during faults, preventing shocks and fires. Neutral bars complete the electrical circuit back to the source, maintaining system stability .
- **Surge Protective Devices (SPDs)** SPDs protect sensitive equipment from voltage spikes caused by lightning or switching surges, enhancing the longevity and safety of the electrical system .
- **Isolators and Switches** Manual isolators allow sections of the circuit to be safely disconnected for maintenance or repairs, often used in combination with MCBs .
